Heritage Early College High School Campus Visit – Tuesday, March 1, 2005 – 10AM to 2:00 PM

Approximately 50 Students from Heritage School will come to the EvCC Campus for an "orientation" to college on March 1st. They will arrive at 10 AM and leave at 2 PM. The purpose of their visit will be as follows:

- 1) to help the students understand how their early college work relates to "going to college."
- 2) to get a picture i.d. from Student activities so they can have library privileges.
- 3) to receive an orientation to the library.
- 4) to visit classes in progress (about 5 students at a time) so they can see what college classes look like.
- 5) to help the students see how to make a plan for college.
